### White Wine

**Reserve St Marc Sauvignon Blanc Pays d'Oc France** NV £18  
 A very pleasant and easy drinking Sauvignon from the south of France. Clean, crisp and fruity it is excellent on its own or with food.

**Terre Valse Pinot Grigio** 2015 £18  
 Aromas of fresh cut wildflowers and honey. The taste is refreshingly dry and fruity with a lingering finish.

**One Chain Vineyards 'The Googly' Chardonnay Australia** 2016 £18  
 Crisp, lively and bright, this citrus scented Chardonnay is well balanced, with tropical fruit and melon flavours.

**Kraal Bay Chenin Blanc** 2016 £20  
 Gentle ripe apple aromas, honeyed aromatics and delicious greengage and citrus lemon acidity on the long finish

**Kientzheim-Kayserberg Pinot Gris Alsace France** 2010 £21  
 Ripe pears and a touch of ginger on the nose that leads to a long, structured palate with plenty of backbone and a just off-dry finish.

**Oropasso Originale, Biscardo Italy** 2016 £24  
 Delicate with floral notes and hints of citrus and yellow flesh fruits. Fresh, mineral, structured and well balanced.

**Sherwood Estate Stoney Range Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ** 2016 £26  
 Classic Kiwi Sauvignon with aromas of gooseberry and green pepper; smooth-textured, lingering palate with mineral and citrus fruit flavours.

**Vondeling Babiana South Africa** 2015 £28  
 A rich and impressive dry white, that is packed full of peach, apricot flavours with a long finish.

**Domaine des Gerbeaux St Veran Burgundy** 2013 £32  
 Typical Saint-Veran, this is a ripe and creamy delight, with flavours of peach tempered by rich buttery oak.

### Rosé

**Domaine Antugnac Turtiles Rosé Pays d'Oc France** 2016 £22  
 This pale rose has an expressive notes of strawberries and cassis. Well rounded, delicious and refreshing.

**St André de Figuière Rosé Provence France** 2016 £25  
 Classy pale Provence rosé, summer red berry fruits with white peach, silky and refreshing.



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### Red Wine

**Reserve St Marc Merlot Pays d'Oc France** **NV** **£18**

A fresh and lively expression of Merlot, ripe dark berry fruit flavours and a hint of liquorice.

**One Chain Vineyards 'The Wrong Un' Shiraz/Cabernet Australia** **2016** **£18**

A rich, well balanced example of the Aussie classic blend. Lush black fruits, woodspice, liquorice and cassis with a delicious, velvety finish.

**Los Haroldos Malbec Mendoza Argentina** **2015** **£22**

Red fruits (cherry, plum and raspberry) are combined with a touch of oak which enhance the presence of chocolate and vanilla.

**Bodegas Medievo Crianza Rioja** **2013** **£24**

Full flavoured and elegant with wild red, black and blue berry flavours combined with balsamic, cedar wood and soft tannins.

**Neropasso Originale Rosso Biscardo Italy** **2015** **£25**

Red cherry, black cherry and plum compote with hints of spice. Fine and velvety, persistent with soft tannins.

**Vondeling Erica Shiraz South Africa** **2011** **£30**

A rich, opulent and spicy red with svelte dark fruits, smooth chocolate and truffle undertones.

**Alain Jaume et Fils Vacqueyras Rhone Valley, France** **2012** **£35**

Deep and intense black fruit flavours, liquorice and spice on the finish. Seriously good Rhone red.

**Clos aux Plantes Saint-Emilion Grand Cru** **2011** **£38**

Deep, rich dark fruit and plum flavours paired with liquorice and graphite. A classic right bank Bordeaux.

**Greywacke Marlborough Pinot Noir New Zealand** **2013** **£49**

Highly aromatic with rich ripe cherry and plum, soft liquorice and a hint of spice. Exotic and fruity.

### Sparkling

**Ca' di Alte Prosecco 20cl** **NV** **£7**

Notes of pear and floral hints is followed by a very bright, clean and lifted, palate. Very dry, with lingering freshness.

**Montecchio Maggiore DOC Prosecco** **NV** **£19**

Pear, nectarine and apricot aromas and flavours balanced by a lively mousse and depth. Classic Prosecco.

**Gyejacquot Frères Champagne Brut** **NV** **£35**

Rich and creamy, and with really lovely peach flavours, a soft mousse and a lasting finish.
